### Person Specification

#### Essential

- A Christian in sympathy with the [Evangelical Alliance Basis of Faith](#) and the [Baptist Union Declaration of Principle](#)
- A member of PBC (or willing to join the membership)
- To maintain personal devotion to Christ through personal prayer and bible reading
- To maintain high standards of Christian conduct (in accordance with our Code of Conduct which can be found in our Staff Handbook)
- To be a person of vision, seeking to develop the ministry of the church in the community in line with the church's vision and strategy
- To have a heartfelt passion for evangelism
- Excellent interpersonal and cross-cultural skills
- To be able to lead and relate to church members warmly, appropriately and sensitively
- Experience in leading forms of outreach ministry
- Experience of leading and training individuals and teams, particularly volunteers
- Have a legal right to live and work in the UK

#### Desirable

- Good written and spoken communication skills
- Good IT skills including competence in the use of MS Office 365
- A high degree of personal maturity, wisdom and tact
- Experience in diverse and adventurous forms of evangelism
- A high degree of personal organisation
- Proven ability in the effective use of social media platforms.
- Theological training

## Role Description

### Key Tasks:

1. To play a leadership role in the life of the church
  - To attend the church's Leadership Team as required
  - To be an enthusiastic and supportive member of the church's staff team attending staff meetings whenever possible
2. Mobilise the church in evangelism
  - Develop and communicate an overall vision and strategic plan for evangelism including both 'in-person' and 'on-line' strategies.
  - Develop evangelism training for church members
  - Organise and oversee evangelistic groups and courses
  - Organise and encourage personal and corporate prayer for the church's outreach activities
3. To pioneer new outreach activities. In particular, this will involve working collaboratively with the Chrysalis team who are working to ensure the new building project accommodates new outreach activities.
4. To work with ministry leaders to ensure the evangelistic effectiveness of the outreach activities of the church, particularly in the community centre in our new premises (to be completed in 2025) which will include a café and sports court.
5. To be an ambassador for the church, deepening relationships and furthering trust with local community organisations
6. On behalf of PBC, develop partnerships with a small number of Christian agencies working to reach out with the gospel, advocate for social justice and / or care for the poor within the UK
7. Other tasks
  - To carry out any reasonable activity or task requested by the Senior Minister or the Leadership Team
  - To be an enthusiastic and supportive member of the church's staff team attending staff meetings whenever possible
  - To be loyal, encouraging and where appropriate offer challenge to other church leaders
  - To pray for the church family both personally and with others – making attendance at PBC prayer meetings a priority
  - Flexibility in working pattern including working some evenings and weekends.
