PURLEY FOOD HUB, together with local churches, will once again be supporting the community this Christmas with two projects - *'Come Dine with Jesus'* and *'Toys for Joy'*.

Come Dine with Jesus:

We will be giving Aldi gift cards to local families who are in crisis so that they can purchase the ingredients for a Christmas meal – the gift cards cannot be used for alcohol or the lottery. Nominations will be made by Purley Food Hub's ticket partners. Accompanying the gift card will be some booklets with a Christian message.

Toys for Joy:

We will be purchasing a toy and chocolate pack for each child nominated by ticket partners, and families will be invited to attend an event at the end of November when they can enjoy crafts and refreshments, as well as selecting a toy for each child. Please note, we are not accepting toys – financial donations only please.

How To Donate:

The value of each Aldi gift card is £75 for a family and £50 for a single person. The cost of a toy and chocolate pack for each child is approximately £15.
